
SolidWorks Standalone License

Installation and Administration Guide

For SolidWorks Education Edition ('02-'03)

Introduction

The following process applies to both new users and those upgrading to the Education Edition for '02-'03.

SolidWorks Installation segment

Install your hardware lock (dongle) on the parallel printer port of your PC

Load CD #1---Select "**Install**"---Select "**Next**"

Select the type of installation you wish: standalone means select "**Individual**"

Target path to the location where you want to install your SW Education Edition: (if you don't like the default location please select "**Browse**" to choose another location)

<If you are upgrading from an previous version of SW you will asked if you want to "**Upgrade your installation**" or "**New installation**". >

Select the additional languages (beyond English) you want SW to operate in: <select **Next**>

Install Component Selection:

The standard components shipped with the Education Edition are checked off and will be installed. If you purchased optional licenses for the other products listed please check these too. <Note, SW MoldBase is installed by using your browser (MS Internet Explorer, etc) to browse the CD to the MoldBase installation selection and select it.>

Check for necessary disk space: <**Next**>

Enter your serial number (supplied with your SolidWorks package), name and school <**Next**>

*Enter your Registration Code, if you have one already (if you are upgrading you will need a new reg. code). If you don't have a new reg code please select "**Next**".*

- If you have not received a new reg code to enter at the time of upgrade installation, you can run the software for a maximum of 30 days.
- To get a new reg. code you will be connected to the SolidWorks registration website (if your PC is connected to the Internet) and asked to register to get your reg.code. This will be emailed or faxed back to you. <**Next**>

Select your preferred Dimensioning Standard Selection: ANSI, ISO, etc. <**Next**>

Select the "Unit Selection" (e.g. inches, mm, etc) that you prefer for your designs.

<Next>

Performance Information Option:

Please choose to allow or not allow your PC to supply SolidWorks with software performance information in your installation. This is designed to help SolidWorks refine the software in future releases. <Next>

Folder Selection:

choose the location where you want your Education Edition icons listed. <Next>

Start Copying Files--<Next>

The installation will now add the SolidWorks software to your PC. This will typically take a few minutes depending on your computer.

Setup Complete! <Finish> for new installers

SolidWorks Toolbox Installation segment

The SolidWorks installation process is now complete and now install will add SolidWorks Toolbox Education Edition on your computer.

Please enter a SolidWorks folder to install this. This is often the same folder as SolidWorks.

<Next>

Select a Toolbox Part File folder:

This is where all of the parts and hardware from Toolbox will be installed.

<accept the default folder unless you wish to locate this elsewhere>

To start Copying Files select <Next> The file copying process will take a few minutes.

When complete select <Finish>

e-Drawings Professional Installation segment

Switch to CD #2 for the final part of the process: installation of eDrawings Professional

Welcome of eDrawings! <Next>

License Agreement:

Review agreement, if acceptable then please choose "I accept the terms in the license agreement" <Next>

Select Installation Choice:

Upgrade or New Installation (choose new if this is a new installation of SolidWorks, or you have not had eDrawings installed before).

An upgrade installation will ask you if you wish to remove your old version of eDrawings. This is almost always preferred.

After this selection, proceed through the steps accepting the defaults.
